



MOBILE VOLUNTEER INSTRUCTIONS

When you get to a polling place:

- When you arrive, go inside and introduce yourself to the election judge.
- While inside, assess the polling place for the accessibility questions on your survey
- Go outside, and station yourself 100 feet from the entrance.
- Complete the polling place survey
- Plan to stay for about half an hour at each site.
 - Hand out the Tips for Voting flyer and invite voters to share their voting experiences.
 - Use your judgment! If there's a lot of voter traffic or you are hearing voters talk about issues, stay a bit longer.

Remember...

- Respect the Voting Process! Monitors are not allowed to stay in the polling area.
- Be Polite! We are a resource for voters, but don't pressure them into taking our materials or talking with us.
- Only answer questions that are covered on the Tips for Voting flyer. If a voter has questions or needs special assistance, refer them to the 866-OURVOTE hotline.

- 5) Employ all legal means to ensure that the ballot of every willing and eligible voter will be cast and counted on Election Day;
- 6) Write a post-election report so the system can be changed if problems are identified
